Project:

We are looking for teachers to help with some regional FY1/2 teaching sessions.

Teachers should ideally be in specialist training (ST3+), but we welcome applications from keen core or early specialist trainees (CT2 level).

Common FAQs:

Sessions will be delivered via zoom at a date of your choice (requires 2 weeks advance notice), starting at approximately 1400 or 1800. Sessions usually last 45-60 minutes but this can be flexible.

The format can be of your choosing - we have had a mixture of simulation/lecture and small group style formats. We try to pair every session with a facilitator to help manage queries and to manage the technical aspects e.g. the waiting room function. Open sessions generally attract between 20-50 participants.

About the "Foundation Cases" teaching series:

Delivering education to trainees has become more challenging during the COVID19 pandemic. As such the 'foundation cases' series has been set up to provide doctors as an alternative to face to face teaching. It is generally running via zoom and is arranged



with the Severn & Peninsula foundation office, Health Education England.
